Site #1) Aspen Restoration Site: This site is located just North of the Dike Road intersection with LeClerc Road North on the West Side of the Road.

Site #2) Aquatic Organism Passage on Cee Cee Ah Creek: Continue North on LeClerc Rd. North and turn right onto Cee Cee Ah Creek Road. Take the right fork onto USFS Rd. #1921 and continue a ¼ mile up #1921 to the site.

Site #3) Intersection of USFS Road #5030 and #1921: The #1921 road rapidly deteriorates after Site #2. To avoid this section of bad road, head back to LeClerc Road North and head South to the intersection with Kings Lake Road. Turn Left on Kings Lake Road follow Kings Lake Road to the intersection with Halfmoon Lake (Rd. #5030) and turn left. Follow Halfmoon Lake Road to the intersection with #1921.

Site #4) Browns Lake Campground: Continue down Halfmoon Lake Rd. and follow the signs to the Browns Lake Campground.

Site #5) Bead Lake Boat Launch: Head back to LeClerc Rd and head South on LeClerc Rd South. Turn Left on Indian Creek Road. Follow Indian Creek Road for approx. 2 miles and turn left on Bead Lake Road. Follow Bead Lake Road until you see the boat launch sign on your right.

Site #6) Geophysical Recreation Site: Head back down Bead Lake Rd. towards Indian Creek Rd. Turn right on Indian Creek Rd and the Geophysical parking area is approx. a mile down on your right.
