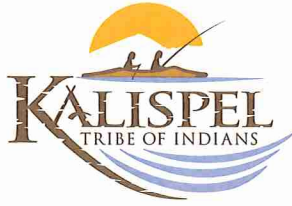

RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, the Kalispel Business Committee is the duly Constituted governing body of the Kalispel Tribe by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws for the Kalispel Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, the Kalispel Business Committee is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security and general welfare of the Kalispel Tribe and all reservation residents; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has promulgated safety, health, and welfare regulations in the Kalispel Law and Order Code (KLOC); and
- WHEREAS, under KLOC Chapter 32 the Tribe is subject to the land use and building standards of Spokane/Pend Oreille County unless the Tribe has adopted its own land use regulations where they relate to leasing of Reservation land; and
- WHEREAS, through the Tribe's inherent authority the Tribe may take such actions necessary to promote the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the Kalispel Tribe and its people, as well as the Reservation and the surrounding communities; and
- WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Tribe to protect the health, safety, and welfare of persons and land uses within tribal lands from impacts related to the operation of airports in the vicinity, namely Fairchild Air Force Base and the Spokane International Airport, and it is the intent to avoid any impacts to operations at those airports resulting from land uses on Reservation lands;
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that KLOC Chapter 33, Land Use and Development Code is hereby added to the KLOC; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that KLOC Chapter 34 is hereby RESERVED for the eventual development and adoption of standards for residential development on tribal lands in Pend Oreille County.
