## RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, the Kalispel Business Committee is the duly Constituted governing body of the Kalispel Tribe by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws for the Kalispel Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, the Kalispel Business Committee is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security and general welfare of the Kalispel Tribe and all reservation residents; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has promulgated safety, health, and welfare regulations through Chapter 4 (Traffic Infractions), Chapter 10 (Kalispel Tobacco and Liquor Code), Chapter 11 (Kalispel Tribe Gaming Ordinance), Chapter 12 (Hunting and Fishing Codes), and Chapter 18 (Fireworks) of the Kalispel Law and Order Code (KLOC); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has determined that adjudication of violations of the above regulations is under the purview of the Kalispel Administrative Court, as outlined in KLOC Chapter 21 (Kalispel Administrative Code); and
- WHEREAS, under KLOC § 21-6.06, the Administrative Court has been limited to using the State of Washington Infraction Rules of Limited Jurisdiction (IRLJ) as a guideline for penalties when regulations are violated; and
- WHEREAS, the IRLJ has been an inadequate penalty guideline for the Administrative Court, given the variety of regulations which are adjudicated in this forum.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that KLOC § 21-6.06 is hereby deleted, and penalties in the Administrative Court shall be determined by the Administrative Law Judge, using guidelines provided in the KLOC chapters in which the regulations are promulgated.

KLOC § 21-6.06 MONETARY PENALTIES (to be deleted)

The Kalispel Business Committee hereby adopts the monetary penalty schedule for infractions for the State of Washington, as set forth in the Infraction Rules of Courts of Limited Jurisdiction, Rule 6.2, as a guideline for the Administrative Court. The Court may impose a lesser penalty in its discretion.
